- Be aware of the usual risks associated with water sports such as drowning, rapidly changing conditions, hypothermia, sunburn fatigue, rocks, waves etc.

- If conditions change while you are on the water and you can no longer control your equipment, return to shore. Do not go out in conditions that are beyond your skill level.
- If you are under age of 18, you must have your parent or legal guardian read these warning and instructions.
- When wind foiling, always use a safety leash so your board is contained.
- We strongly recommend you wear a helmet to avoid injury from your board or other hard objects.
- We strongly recommend you wear a Personal Flotation Device (PFD) or impact vest.
- Choose a full-length wetsuit or shorty depending on the water temperature. Be aware that you will use more energy when you are cold.

1. FOIL SAFETY

Wind foiling and Foil boarding come with a unique set of risks and dangers above those inherent to the sport of wing foiling or foil boarding. In order to keep yourselves and others safe in the water, we recommend use extra caution and implement these basic safety precautions:

- Aztron strongly recommends wing foil or related lessons for first-time foil users. Wing foiling and foil boarding are dangerous activity and should be treated with caution.
- Check your board condition with all the accessories and components before each use to ensure all connections are tight and in proper working order.
- Do not foil in shallow water, and use extreme caution when foiling near other people and objects.
- We recommend wearing a helmet with ear protection at all times and a wetsuit (especially when learning), to help protect yourself from impacts with your board and foil.
- Use care when transporting your board, to ensure the safety of yourself and others, and to protect the longevity of your equipment.
- Use extreme caution when placing your foil and foil board on the beach, as there can be a danger to other riders, general beach users and your own equipment.
- We recommend using a Aztron board, wing, and foil system gear bag for your Foil-set, to provide maximum protection and longevity of the products.

2. FOIL ASSEMBLY

SCREW SET FOR FALCON FOIL BOARD

4 x M6x28 TH 4 x T-Nuts



NOTE: Boards are sold separately. The Aztron foil Boards can be purchased additionally at a Aztron Retailer.

Do not use power tools for installation as it may cause damage as control of torque and power is limited. Doing so will render your warranty void.

Over tightening screws can cause irreversible damage to the inserts, track and T-Nuts. Doing so will render your warranty void.




2.1 ATTACHING YOUR ROCKET FOIL TO AZTRON FOIL BOARDS

T-Nuts pre-inserted into the board tracks

- Ensure all surfaces are free from dirt or sand prior to assembly. Pay close attention to the Board Adaptor on the foil system and board tracks.
- Insert one T-Nut into each track using the central track entry points, ensuring the correct T-Nut orientation is maintained as per the diagram (Diagram 1). Slide the T-Nuts towards the tail of the board until they are at the far back end of the tracks.



2.2 DISASSEMBLAGE

Untighten the four screws of the top plate and pull out the four T-nuts through the center opening of the tracks. Keep the T-nuts and screws tightened together to keep them safe.

2.3 ADJUSTMENT

The ideal location of the foil depends on its dimensions and design; it can therefore vary for each different foil. Place the foil in a central position as a first reference. The foil will rise up sooner and more strongly when it is located in a more forward position (more front foot pressure). It will rise up less when located in a more backward position (less front foot pressure).



3.FIT THE FOOT STRAPS





To install the optional Footstraps, follow the steps below. Notice the foot straps are not included in the board package.

- Use the screws provided in the Footstrap pack with a Philips screws driver. Choose your
 preferred position amongst the selection of positions. If you are not sure, use the central
 positions.
- 2. Fasten the screws, through the foot strap, into the plastic insert of the board. Do not forget the washers and watch the angle of the screw to avoid damaging the board.

4.CARE AND MAINTENANCE

It is recommended to use AZTRON foils together with AZTRON accessories. Regularly check your board for holes coming from any damage. In case you find any damage, make sure these are sealed and fixed properly before further use.

STORAGE

Keep your board in a well-ventilated and shaded area when you do not use it. Your board can be damaged if it is exposed to direct sunlight for a period of time. Keep your board in an area with good air flow and circulation.

- Do not leave your board exposed to the sun on the beach for too long. Limited exposure of the deck-side of the board to direct sunlight.
- · While in use, water flowing over the deck helps regulate surface temperature. However,
- when the deck traction pad is dry, the heat absorption effect is amplified when exposed to direct sunlight.
- At approximately 74°C/165°F, all EPS foam begins outgassing, becomes unstable and delaminate.
- Leaving your board in a vehicle during the day, even on a mild day, increases the risk of delamination.

5.TRANSPORTATION

By Hand:

- Carry the board by using the carrying handle.
- If necessary, use a transport cart to help with the transport.

By Vehicle:

- When strapping to the top of your car, place the board underside up. Placing the top side up may generate wind drag and instability when driving.
- Place the front or the back of the board forward are both acceptable.
- · Overtightening straps may result in pressure dings.
- Use padded strap instead of non-padded nylon straps.







6.SERIAL NUMBER

Find the Serial Number on the board back. It is 12 characters long
